## PARKING and TRANSPORTATION plan

ALL walks to end at Summerveld Estate.

### Directions to the vehicle parking area at the FINISH

#### Directions from Thomas More College

- Proceed from the school to the M13 Highway.
- Drive north (direction Pietermaritzburg) along the M13 past Hillcrest and on to the Kassier Road off ramp, near the mushroom farm.
- Turn left into Kassier Road, head in a southerly direction back over the N3.

#### Directions from Kassier Road.

- Kassier road becomes the MR454.
- Continue down road MR 454 to the Summerveld turn off. (You will have passed the MR 559 which leads to the Enviro serve land fill and Shongweni Dam).
- At the Summerveld turn off, turn right into JB McIntosh Road and proceed approximately 3.2 km up JB McIntosh.
- You will pass a sugar cane field on your left and then open field (where old ponds stop was), continue along the road; you will go under a bridge and you will pass paddocks on your left and right and then the training track on your left; keep going along till you see an open field on your left (new end stop).
- Follow parking signs where there will be sufficient parking behind the field.

### Intermediate Walk 55 & 80 km:

- Starts at Thomas More College at 02:00.
- Sweeper vehicles to collect walkers and transfer them to the breakfast stop if they cannot make it to breakfast or to the finish at End Stop if the walker has passed breakfast stop and cannot make it to the end.
- Hourly bus service from the Finish back to Thomas More College from 12:00 to 16:00.
- After 17:00 sweeper vehicles to transport walkers back to Thomas More College, sweeper vehicle to leave once filled.

### Mini Walk 25 km:

- All Senior Primary students to register at End Stop.
- Walkers to be lifted by parents to the Start at End Stop by 07:00 for registration. Walk scheduled to start at 07:30 and to end again at the FINISH.
- Parents/Adults assisting in transportation of the 25 km walkers to the Start are please to refer to the direction given above.
