REGISTRATION DETAILS

FIRST AND FOREMOST:

All Thomas More students from Grade 4 to 12 are registered automatically. Teachers, Parents and Outsiders all need to register at the dates and times listed below.

No walkers under the age of 12 will be permitted to register to do the 55/80km long walk.

High School students (walking the 55/80km) will get their bibs at class registration the day before the walk. Bibs must be brought to the school on the Saturday morning, and students must find their Grade registration table and register their attendance.

Grade 7 students who have qualified to walk 55km will get their bibs from the teacher on Grade 7 registration duty on the Saturday morning when they register their attendance.

Grade 4 to 7 students will be handed their bibs at registration at Summerveld Estate on the morning of the long walk.

Foundation Phase students Grade 1 -3 are all controlled by the Foundation Phase (this includes designated parent helpers). All walk detail correspondence will be communicated directly by the Foundation Phase Head.

FEE STRUCTURE:

All TMC students long walk fees are added to the school account. These fees are charged to cover the cost of catering, water, etc. for the walkers. Outsider payments to be made in CASH i.e. No Credit Cards.

Entry fees are non-refundable should the Long Walk be cancelled for any reason whatsoever.

Grade 4 – 7 students and parents walking the MINI WALK (25km)	R 160
Grade 7 students entering the INTERMEDIATE WALK (55km)	R 210
Grade 8 – 12 students, past students and parents entering the INTERMEDIATE (55km) & LONG WALK (80km)	R 210
Visitors/Clubs – 25km	R 220
Visitors/Clubs – 55km/80km	R 350

OUTSIDER (PARENTS, PAST STUDENTS, VISITORS AND CLUBS) REGISTRATION

Registration is a quick online process done AT THE SCHOOL (follow signs from driveway entrance) in order to capture all your relevant details, take payment, receive your bib and sign your indemnity form. Payment can be in the form of cash, or for TMC parents on your school account (please have your account number handy).

If you are unable to attend the above registration days in person for any reason you are able have someone register on your behalf by means of a personally completed Entry form and signed Indemnity form. Please email rgriesel@thomasmore.co.za and these forms will be forwarded to you.

Any persons under 18 have to be accompanied by a parent/guardian on date of registration in order to sign the indemnity and ensure all medical conditions are disclosed on the on-line registration. TMC Students will also not be allowed to sign indemnity forms on behalf of their parents.

Please note that for safety reasons/catering requirements, we have a cut off limit of a **TOTAL of 1650 walkers** on the day which allows us 650 outsiders (parents, past students, visitors and clubs) only. **Registration is done on a first come first serve basis.**

DAY OF WALK REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

25km Walk

Start 07:30 Summerveld Estate (Own transport required to Start)

TMC Students must arrive at their starting points 30 minutes before the start to find their Grade registration table and register their attendance.

55km & 80km Walk

Start 02:00 Thomas More College - Finish Summerveld Estate (Buses leave from Summerveld Estate at regular intervals back to TMC).

TMC Students must arrive at their starting points 30 minutes before the start to find their Grade registration table and register their attendance.

Outsider's should arrive at the school about 15 minutes before the start. They don't need to register their attendance, but should notify Walker Control should they not be walking for whatever reason.

Any participant who arrives at a Stop before the scheduled opening times will be stopped and will have to wait until the opening marshal allows you to continue. This is done for your own safety.
