Participation

1. The competition is conducted by The Thomas More College Parents’ Council.
2. This competition is open to any Thomas More College Parents, but excluding staff of Thomas More College.

Entries:

1. The competition runs termly. No late entries will be accepted.
2. To enter the competition participants need to have paid their termly fee.
3. A family may only enter once.
4. The winner will be randomly chosen via a lucky draw.
5. No responsibility will be accepted for entries lost, delayed or damaged in transmission.
6. Entries reflected on The Thomas More College Parents’ Council records will be treated as the only validation source and will be the only evidence of successful entries.

Closing Dates:

Entries must be received by the date of the draw.

Prizes:

1. The prizes will be a terms schools fee refund for the oldest Thomas More College pupil in the winning family.
2. The winners will be announced at the termly formal Parents’ Council fund raising event.
