REGISTRATION DETAILS

FIRST AND FOREMOST:

All Thomas More students from Grade 4 to 12 are registered automatically. Teachers, Parents and Visitors all need to register at the dates and times listed below.

No under 14 year old visitors or Primary School walkers will be permitted to register to do the 55/80km Long Walk.

High School students (walking the 55/80km) will get their bibs at class registration the day before the walk. Bibs and timing tags must be brought to the start on the Saturday morning.

Grade 4 to 7 students will be handed their bibs at registration on the morning of the Long Walk.

Foundation Phase students, Grade 1 - 3 are all controlled by the Foundation Phase staff (this includes designated parent helpers). All walk detail correspondence will be communicated directly by the Foundation Phase Head.

FEE STRUCTURE:

All TMC students Long Walk fees are added to the school account. These fees are charged to cover the cost of catering, water, etc. for the walkers.

Visitor payments to be made in **Cash / Credit Card (TBC) / Zapper (TBC)** if all service providers signal strength and facilities are working correctly.

*Entry fees are **non-refundable** should the Long Walk be cancelled for any reason whatsoever.*

Grade 4 – 7 students and parents walking the MINI WALK (25km) @ 07h30	R 210
Grade 8 – 12 students, past students and parents entering the INTERMEDIATE (55km) & LONG WALK (80km) @ 01h00	R 300
Visitors/Clubs – 25km @ 07h30	R 340
Visitors/Clubs – 55km/80km @ 01h00	R 440

OUTSIDER (PARENTS, PAST STUDENTS, VISITORS AND CLUBS) REGISTRATION

*Registration is a quick process done AT THE SCHOOL (follow signs from driveway entrance) in order to capture all your relevant details, take payment, receive your bib and sign your indemnity form. Payment can be in the form of **cash, credit card or zapper** (provided that all the service providers signal strength and facilities are working correctly on the day, or for TMC parents on your school account (please have your account number handy).*

There will be NO Late registration.

If you are unable to attend the above registration days in person for any reason, you will be able to have someone (over the age of 18 years) register on your behalf by means of a personally completed Entry form and signed Indemnity form. Please email rgriesel@thomasmore.co.za between 9 – 12 March 2020 only and these forms will be forwarded to you.

*Any visitors/past pupils under the age of 18 have to be accompanied by a parent/guardian on date of registration in order to sign the indemnity and ensure all medical conditions are disclosed on the registration entry form. TMC Students will **not be** allowed to sign indemnity forms on behalf of their parents.*

Please note that for safety reasons/catering requirements, we have a cut off limit of a **TOTAL of 1650 walkers** on the day which allows us 650 outsiders (parents, past students, visitors and clubs) only. **Registration is done on a first come first served basis.**

DAY OF WALK REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

25km Walk

Start 07h30 at Elizabeth Road Park in Westriding. (Own transport required to Start)

TMC Students will be issued with their bibs on Saturday 14th March 2020 at 07h00 at the start. Once children have **collected their bibs**, been checked in by the teacher that they have **their timing tag**, attached, they may proceed to the holding zones prior to the official Senior Primary start at 07h30.

Parents/visitors to arrive with their bibs and timing tags and can proceed directly to the start and await for the official start at 07h30.

55km & 80km Walk

Start 01:00 at Thomas More College and the finish is on the Savory Field at Thomas More College.

TMC Students must arrive at their starting points 30 minutes before the start with their bibs and timing tags.

Visitors should arrive on campus about 15 minutes before the start. They are welcome to leave their cars in the demarcated car park. They don't need to register their attendance, **but should notify Walker Control should they not be walking for whatever reason – Rae Griesel 083 309 8907.**

Any participant who arrives at a Stop before the scheduled opening times will be stopped and will have to wait until the opening marshal allows you to continue. This is done for your own safety and will be strictly enforced.
