These rules are the official rules of the competition ("rules"). These rules (together with any official competition communications) will govern and apply to the competition. Please take a moment to review these rules. By your participation, you agree that these rules will govern all aspects of your relationship with the competition and the Thomas More College Parents’ Council. These rules can only be modified (or superseded) by The Thomas More College Parents Council (in its reasonable discretion) in a written revision to these rules posted on any potential official competition communication methods reasonably calculated to reach a majority of potential participants.

Participation

1. The competition is conducted by The Thomas More College Parents’ Council.
2. This competition is open to anyone.

Entries:

1. The competition runs from middle of June 2020 to 25 July 2020. No late entries will be accepted.
2. To enter the competition participants need to buy a raffle ticket.
3. A person may enter as many times as they like.
4. The winner will be randomly chosen via a lucky draw to held on the Country Fair day.
5. No responsibility will be accepted for entries lost, delayed or damaged in transmission.
6. Entries reflected on The Thomas More College Parents’ Council records will be treated as the only validation source and will be the only evidence of successful entries.

Closing Dates:

Entries must be received by the Thomas More College Parents’ Council no later than 12h00 on 25 July 2020.

Prizes:

1. The prizes will consist of the list of prizes as printed on the raffle ticket.
2. The winners will be announced after the Country Fair between 29 July to 7 August 2020.
3. The prizes will be available for collection between 7.30am and 15.00pm from the Parents’ Council Secretary’s office based in the Great House on the Thomas More College campus.
4. The prizes are not transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.
5. In the event of the Thomas More College Parents’ Council are unable to contact the finalists they reserve the right to defer the prize to the next Parents’ Council fundraising event.
6. In the event of the prize not being collected within 3 months of the winner being informed about the prize, the Thomas More College Parents’ Council reserve the right to defer the prize to the next Parents’ Council fundraising event.
7. In the event of the winner declining the prize, the Thomas More College Parents’ Council reserve the right to defer the prize to the next Parents’ Council fundraising event.
8. The Thomas More College Parents’ Council reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if the original prize is unavailable.
9. The Thomas More College Parents’ Council are not responsible for any damaged prize items as the prizes are donated.
10. The prize may be subject to additional terms and conditions that the prize winner must comply with.
